It is well-reported that compressor stations are a source of major air and noise pollution. Particularly where this compressor station is sited it is in an area of already overburdened, environmental justice communities that deal with environmental health issues such as asthma and other respiratory illnesses. Additionally the construction of this project goes against our state's efforts to fight climate change. Methane is reported to be drastically more damaging to the environment than carbon and thus we should stop building and start deconstructing gas infrastructure to replace it with cleaner wind and solar energy.
